RESTRICTIONS

Based on availability of rooms and judges, we reserve the right to impose restrictions on team entries or collapse divisions as needed.

JUDGING REQUIREMENTS

Schools **MUST** provide judges to help cover a reasonable portion of their team entry. Restrictions may be imposed for schools that do not adequately provide enough judges. Please use the following guidelines to determine your judging needs:

IEs: one judge covers eight entries
Debate: one judge covers four debaters in a single event (e.g., two entries in NPDA, or two entries in BP, or four entries in IPDA)

ENTRY FEES

School fee	\$ 40
NFC fee (NFC Schools)	\$ 4.50 per student
Debate	\$ 35 per debater
IEs	\$ 10 per entry

UNCOVERED ENTRY FEES

Debate judge	\$ 75 per debater
IE judge	\$ 15 per entry
